As a follow-up to the international symposium 'The Essential Beauty of Tree Avenues' last November, we are gradually uploading the presentations and videos on our website. The next step will be the preparation of the proceedings, and the dissemination of the joint statement on tree avenues and road safety. We will also start a project on tree avenues and cultural tourism.

The annual technical meeting (Rencontres nationales des acteurs des allées d'arbres) will take place in October (European Avenue Day).

The 5th edition of the Artistic Observatory of the avenue in Trampot (Vosges) will see Constance Fulda continue the rubbings of the trunks of the ash trees. Her artistic work should be completed this year so that we are already planning an exhibition for 2025. Please tell us if you know of any venues that could host it.

American photographer Wayne Gudmundson, whose pictures are featured in the collections of the Museum of Modern Art in New York and San Francisco, will also contribute to the Observatory in June. The exhibition prints will be produced during his residency at the Tusen Takk Foundation <https://www.tusentakk.org/artists/wayne-gudmundson>. Wayne Gudmundson will be back in Trampot in November to donate the images for exhibition.

November should also see the publication of the comic book by author and illustrator Mathieu Flammarion

We will also continue to share knowledge and tools with all stakeholders through conferences and other actions.
